RE-OPENING FOR WORSHIP DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC:

Trinity Church has been risk assessed according to Government, Baptist, Methodist and URC guidelines.

Please read the following information for the safety of all who visit Trinity:

- Sunday worship is not planned until September, and will only take place following Government, Baptist, Methodist and URC guidance.
- The only areas open for use in the church are: the vestibule, toilets and main sanctuary. All other areas are strictly out of use.
- These whole premises have been deep cleaned according to Government and denominational guidelines.
- Social Distancing must be carried out by those from different households.
- The toilets are for emergency use only. Only one person should be in the cubicle/handwashing area at any time. Please leave the outer door open and use the anti-bacterial sanitiser supplied to clean areas that you have touched. Place used wipes/towels/tissues etc in the bins provided.
- There will be two Elders/Stewards on duty.
- Please do not attend church if you, or a member of your household, have shown any symptoms of Covid-19 ((a new continuous cough or high temperature) in the previous 14 days. Your temperature will be taken as you enter the premises.
- On entering the church, you should sanitise your hands using the dispenser on the wall. You should wear a face covering.
- Your name will be recorded in a register. If it is found someone has attended and developed symptoms of Covid-19, all who have been in contact with them on the same day will be notified. The building will then be closed for deep cleaning.
- The number of people able to attend at any one time is limited. The Elder/Steward on duty will show you to a seat. Please be patient if someone else has arrived just before you.
- Entry to the church will be via the main door only.
- Exit of the church will be via the side door only. (Fire Exit)
- On leaving the building please sanitise your hands at the table by the exit door and leave used face masks and other rubbish in the bin liner there.
- All hymn books and Bibles have been taken out of use but you may bring your own Bible if you wish.
- Singing is not permitted at the moment.
- There will be no flowers on display.
- Offertory will be placed in a plate at the main door as you enter the church.
- If you feel you will need a drink please bring a water bottle with you.
- Please do not feel pressured into making your decision to attend church or not. This must be a personal choice. We will be delighted to see you when you feel able. The most important thing for you is to keep safe and well.
- While we are pleased to see you, you will appreciate that there can be no handshaking etc. until the Government and our denominations tell us otherwise – a smile is just as welcoming!
